## From The Principal



Welcome back to another fortnight at Montville State School. It has been a very interesting 2 weeks and I am very pleased to see the students back in class and learning at school. I would like to thank the staff and parents for their willingness to adhere to the ever-changing range of restrictions and regulations. From Monday I am very pleased to advise of the following:

**- Parents, volunteers and visitors can come on site.**

**- All adults are required to carry a mask and only need to wear a mask indoors if they can't maintain a 1.5 m distance. No mask is required to be worn outdoors.**

**- Assembly can be held with parents in attendance as long as they maintain a 1.5m distance from other adults.**

The COVID restrictions have also meant that our school review that was scheduled for today and tomorrow has been postponed and will now occur in Term 4 on November 11-12.

This week is Science Week (14–22 August). Unfortunately, we have had to cancel the Street Science performance we had planned for Friday. The department of Education has produced two entertaining science videos featuring educator Phil Breslin. The [Ground oven - states of matter](#) explores contemporary and traditional methods of cooking, and [Stingrays - animal adaptations](#) shows how Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples have observed and used the adaptations of organisms.

Whilst some things are cancelled, others are still going ahead. Our Year 4-6 students will be going to Glenview State School on Thursday 2 September for the Small Schools Oztag Carnival. Notes will be out soon.

This Tuesday we will be holding a Dress Up Day to celebrate two things – Book Week and the 125 Anniversary of Montville State School. The students are asked to dress up as if they are a student that attended Montville State School in the past. We will have Simon Lutkin here to take photos of the students and edit them so that they look as if they are 100 years old. If your child would prefer they can also dress up to the Book Week theme of Old Worlds, New Worlds, Other Worlds. Unfortunately, we won't be holding a parade to show off the costumes but plenty of photos will be taken and shared on Class Dojo.

This Wednesday at 3pm we will be holding a special meeting in lieu of a regular P&C general meeting to hold elections for the roles of President and Vice-President of the P&C. Ben Child has decided to step down as president and I want to say a sincere thank you to Ben for all of his hard work over the last 6 months. There will be staff available to watch the students after school whilst the meeting is being held. I would like to encourage anyone that may be interested in either position or would like any further information to please contact the office.

Finally, the 2021 Premier's Reading Challenge is coming to a close on Friday 27 August. All students are welcome to participate and are required to read 20 books.
