

# Student Leader's Buddy Program

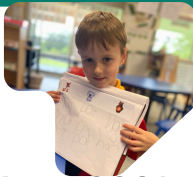


Each week the Preps and Year 6s come together to read, do activities and spend time together. They form close bonds and friendships and enjoy seeing one another out at play times.
